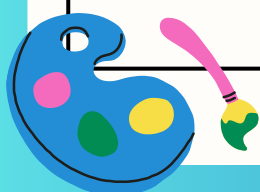

Dear Parents and Carers,

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tie (Years 3-6) | pale grey with capstan blue and gold stripe – (Lads & Lasses <u>Schoolwear Ltd</u> – formerly Bristow's) |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shirt / blouse (Years 3-6) | white with collar suitable for a tie, long or short sleeved (should be able to comfortably tuck in) |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Skirt / pinafore | grey, knee length |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Trousers / shorts | grey, tailored with minimal <u>detailing</u> |
